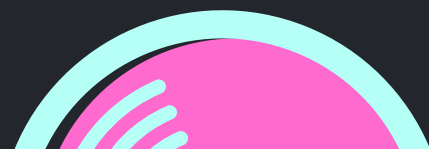
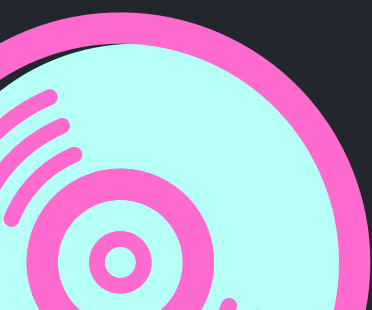
1 | LED: around Flagpole

entry/staircase



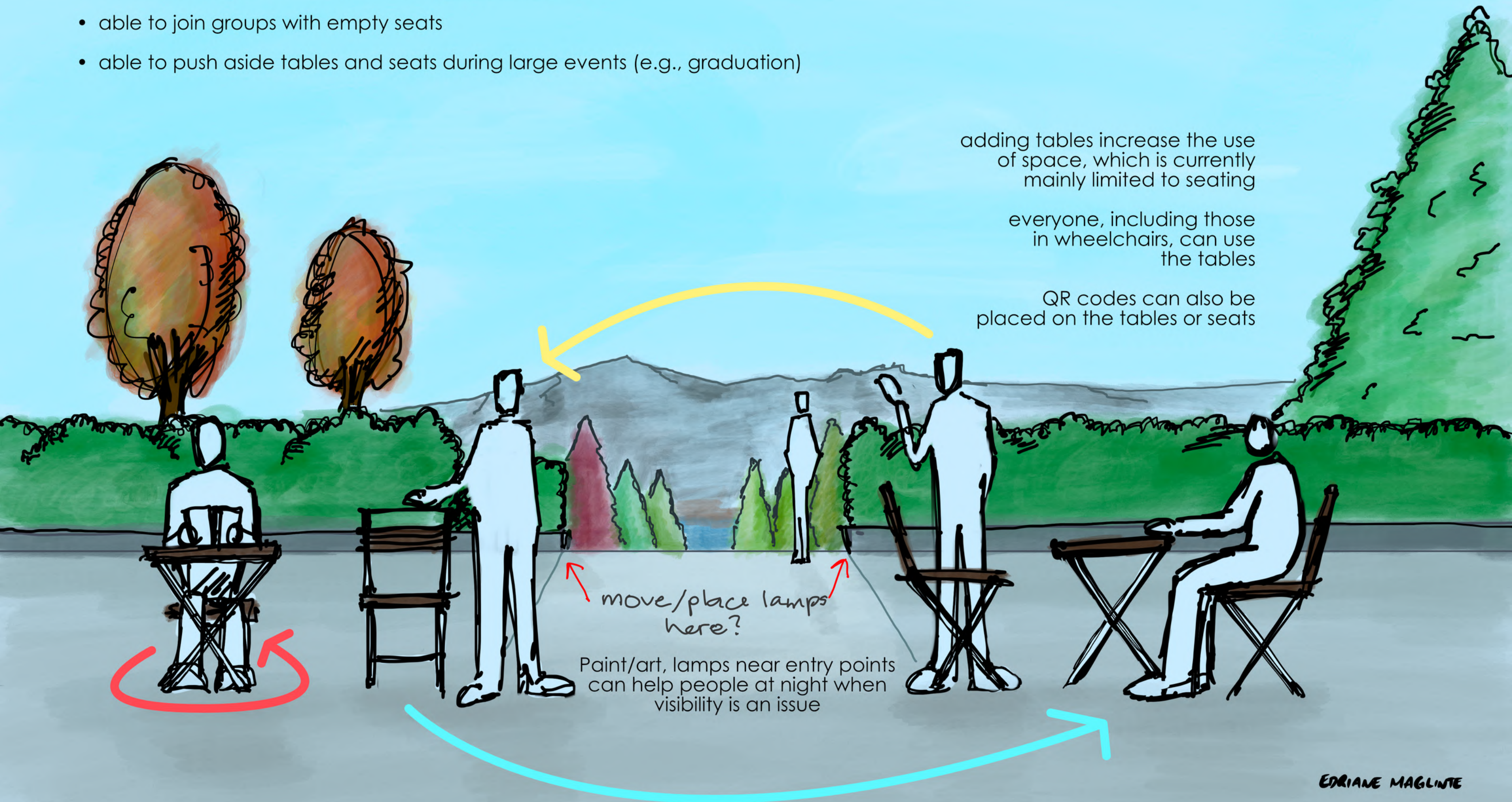
## Suggestion: seats and tables

- able to change view without moving to another seat
- able to join groups with empty seats
- able to push aside tables and seats during large events (e.g., graduation)

adding tables increase the use of space, which is currently mainly limited to seating

everyone, including those in wheelchairs, can use the tables
